

Instructions: Read this information before you begin the survey.

What is this? You are being asked to take part in a research study. This means we want to learn more by asking you some questions and letting you try out a game. It's totally your choice whether you want to be in the study or not.

What will I be doing? If you agree to be in the study, here's what you'll do:

- 1. You'll take a short survey (starting on the next page, will take about 3-5 minutes) before you play the game.
- 2. You'll play a virtual reality (VR) game called *Play Higher* for about 20-25 minutes. The game shows you what it's like to work as a social worker helping people.
- 3. After the game, you'll take another survey (about 15 minutes) to tell us what you learned and how the game felt to play, and if you liked it or not.

Do I have to do this survey? No. You don't have to complete the survey if you don't want to. Nobody will be upset if you say no. You can also stop at any time, even after you start. You can skip any questions you don't want to answer.

Will I get in trouble if I don't? Nope! This is not a test, and it won't affect your grade. You won't get in trouble if you choose not to take part.

Is it safe? Yes. The game is safe, but sometimes VR can make people feel dizzy or get a headache. If that happens, you can stop playing right away. There's also a computer version for your Chromebook you can use instead of the VR headset if you'd rather do that.

Will anyone know what my answers are? Your answers are private. We will not use your name in anything we write about the study. Only the researchers will see your answers.

Do I get anything for being in the study? You won't get money or a prize, but you'll get to try out a cool game and you might even find out about a job that you're interested in!




